1. VESSEL INTRODUCTION

M/V POSEIDON EXPRESS is a Cyprus-flagged passenger/Ro-Ro cargo vessel available for suitable chartering, project cargo, passenger transport and mixed Ro-Ro employment, subject to Owners' approval and vessel availability.

The vessel was built in **1990 at Gdańsk Shipyard, Poland** and has an overall length of approximately **159 m**, beam of **25.3 m**, gross tonnage of **24,727**, and deadweight of **10,996 MT**.

The vessel is currently associated with the **Safaga–Duba/Red Sea corridor**, making her particularly relevant for Red Sea, Middle East, East African and Mediterranean-related employment.
